SYNOPSIS

We open in 2003 with Jess identifying the body of her son. A short teaser before scrolling back to 1999 when Nick and Jess are at University in Wales.

Nick is reclusive but friendly and popular. Liked by his flat mates and the caving club but spends a lot of time alone and disappears up the hill behind the college where he appears to be building something in the woods.

Jess is confident and gregarious. Lives with Ceri and is close to Emma. Somewhat sexually rapacious she is attracted to physically imposing confident men such as Ben, one of Nick's flat mates. She goes on a caving trip in order to try and engage him but ends up getting close to Nick instead.

Whilst he's not 'her type' she is intrigued by him, likes him, responds to his sensitivity. A friendship beyond friendship develops but never quite tips over into romance or sex.

Nick lets Jess into his secret. He's built a sort of tree house in the woods as a project and a retreat and they begin to meet there.

Eventually, in a moment of intimacy, she makes a move but Nick can't reciprocate and they rebound hurt and angry.

We all need a break. Over the summer, Nick and Jess write to each other and there is a tentative rapprochement.

On returning this is cemented and they revive a friendship with a little more distance.

Jess's parents visit and Jess is shown to be poised on the cusp between childhood and adulthood and needing to push away from them. We find out about her mother's infidelity.

Jess has a birthday party and hooks up with Derek, another strong confident lad but of the Public School mould. Sexually fulfilling but ultimately doomed. Nick fades into the background somewhat.

Things deteriorate with Derek culminating in an incident at a rugby match where he injures a friend on the pitch (Bruce) and then takes a swing at Nick when he tries to defend Jess.

At the end of the Michaelmas Term when most of the students have left Jess is pursued in the dark by a group of men from the town. She escapes but falls into a stream.

Hypothermic she manages to reach Nick who warms her up in a bath, probably saving her life. The ensuing intimacy leads to a sexual encounter and this time, for reasons we'll only understand later, Nick reciprocates.
